

UNIQUE APPROACH TO TRAINING

Veterinary Hyperbaric Safety offers a unique approach to training the safety and use of Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy (HBOT) in veterinary medicine by providing a **three-phased** program. Initial consultation through HBOT chamber selection and installation is Phase I. Phase II provides the tools, accessories and comprehensive, on-going training in the Safety/Training/Use and Marketing of the HBOT chamber. Phase II begins with a multi-day, on-site interactive training program with actual patients receiving treatments in the chamber, once it is fully operational. During Phase II VHS will function as the HBOT experienced member of the medical team, available to consult on specific individual cases, and for general questions. Phase III is a continuation of on-going weekly/monthly Training of Safety and Use Programs and the continuation of the consultation call service.

Phase I

- Assistance and consultation in the analysis and selection of the HBOT chamber for a specific location and anticipated uses;
- Assistance in selecting the location within the facility and consult on the accessories, tools, equipment, oxygen, etc. required and necessary for operating the chamber correctly and safely.
- Participation in telephone discussions with various vendors and individuals in the purchasing, maintenance, installation and initial operations of the HBOT chamber including but not limited to manufacturers, distributors, engineers, contractors or subcontractors, installers, HBOT chamber service contracts.

Phase II

Phase II commences with the VHS team spending multiple days (and evenings) on site. Included in this phase are all training and marketing materials, as well as a dinner with the practice owner and one potential referring veterinarian on one of the evenings. For the chamber, VHS provides up to three custom-made small animal treatment modules, patient grounding accessories, grounding test meter, patient loading ramp, oxygen monitor calibration apparatus, HBOT teaching videos. Customized folders of marketing and informational material for a group lecture and future marketing efforts are provided. A two-hour evening lecture (on another open night of the VHS visit) is also included.

Most importantly, Dr. Ron & Kip Lyman become members of the medical and marketing teams. Comprehensive, interactive on-going Safety/Training Services and consultation on treatment specific disease entities are available 7 days a week throughout this Phase. Dr. and Mrs. Lyman

remain available by email, telephone calls, Skype, Facetime, etc. for a full calendar year following the commencement of Phase II.

Phase III

At the conclusion of the Phase II calendar year, there is an option to continue with the weekly/monthly on-going safety training programs. Very importantly, this allows VHS* to remain as members of the medical and marketing teams, and for the continuation of consulting calls on all matters of HBOT, indications, safety and use of the chamber.
