

# Training Options for Safe Operation of Sechrist Veterinary Hyperbaric Chambers



## **Sechrist Online and Onsite Safe Operation of the Sechrist Veterinary Hyperbaric Chamber:**

Sechrist provides online education on the fundamentals of Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy (HBOT) with every chamber purchased. The online course will be completed prior to chamber delivery. At the time of installation, half-day in-service equipment training will take place. Once complete a two-day hands-on training program, taught by a certified veterinary hyperbaric technologist, for core chamber staff, will focus on chamber usage safety and competency check-offs.

## **Sechrist Clinical Applications of Veterinary Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy and Safe Use of the Sechrist Veterinary Hyperbaric Chamber:**

Our two-day onsite education and training program, from an experienced Veterinary Hyperbaric DVM, CHT-V also includes lectures and hands-on patient treatments. As well as, one-year DVM to DVM clinical support via phone and electronic communications.

## **Hyperbaric Medicine Team Training for Animal Application – San Antonio, TX:**

This 42 hr course is an inter-professional educational activity that fills a knowledge gap in veterinary hyperbaric medicine. It is the first step toward certification in this specialty field of veterinary medicine. VHMC is approved as an introductory course in hyperbaric medicine by the National Board of Diving and Hyperbaric Medical Technology (NBDHMT) as a prerequisite to sit the certification exam for Certified Hyperbaric Technologist-Veterinary (CHT-V). Module 1 academics over the first three days include currently accepted standards for safe application of hyperbaric oxygen therapy for humans and adds an opportunity to experience hyperbaric chamber pressurization. Module 2 is animal specific instruction pertaining to large and small animals. A faculty of experts presents a comprehensive curriculum. Note: Does not include hands-on training conducted actual patient treatments.
